- vuosien 1979 – 1996 aikana valmensi siellä kaikilla tasoilla lasten temppukouluista eliitti voimistelijoihin
- työskenteli USA Gymnastics 1996 – 2001
- telinevoimistelutuomari yli 30 vuoden ajalta
- oli TOPS testaaaja 8 vuoden ajan
- on valmentanut mm. seuraavia voimisteliijoita:
 - Mohini Bharwaj - 2004 Olympian
 - Samantha Peszek – 2008 Olympic Team Member
- pitänyt lukuisia luentoja eri kongresseissa ja klinikoilla ja lupautunut pitämään valmentajille luennon puomivalmennuksesta myös Kuortaneen leirillä!
- työskenteli teknisenä konsulttina/päävalmentajan Disneyn elokuvassa “Stick It”



Näin Pat kertoo itsestään:

“I recently moved back to Indy after living in California for 4 years. I went to LA in the spring of 2005 to work on the Disney movie “Stick It” with my daughter Dona. I was the Technical Consultant/Gymnastics Coach and my daughter Dona was the Assistant Gymnastics Coach and Choreographer.

I have been coaching, judging, teaching preschool and recreational gymnastics for 30 years. My career started at Queen City Gymnastics in 1979 under the ownership of Jeff Metzger. When I retired from coaching in 1996 we had reached a peak enrollment of 967 preschoolers. Gary Warren and I coached together for 15 yrs and produced 7 National Team Members, one alternate to the World Team in 1991 and over 25 athletes that attended college on a full or partial gymnastics scholarship.

Mohini Bhardwaj, who made the 2004 Olympic Team was our athlete from age 4-14 years old. I also coached Samantha Peszek, 2008 Olympian, who was my athlete for 3 1/2 yrs. She just won beam at 2011 NCAA Nationals!

I am very excited about coming to Kuortane, Finland for the camp next summer!”
